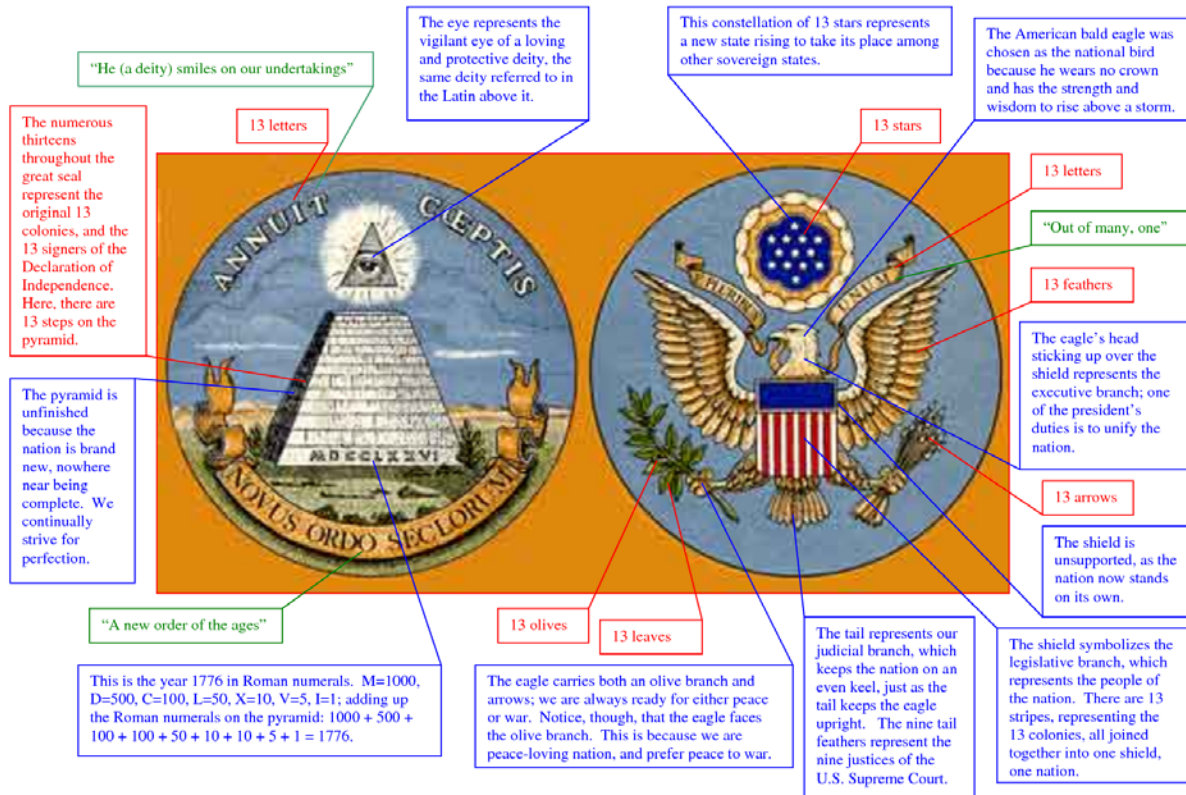
## America's [religious, political, and ideological concepts] of U.S.

The phrase *Novus ordo seclorum* (Latin for "New order of the ages") appears on the reverse of the Great Seal of the United States, first designed in 1782 and printed on the back of the United States one-dollar bill since 1935. *Novus ordo seclorum* is the Latin motto suggested in 1782 by Charles Thomson, the Founding Father chosen by Continental Congress to come up with the final design for the Great Seal of the United States. On June 20, 1782, Congress approved Thomson's design for both sides of the Great Seal.

The 1782 resolution adopting the seal blazons the image on the reverse as "A pyramid unfinished. In the zenith an eye in a triangle, surrounded by a glory, proper." The pyramid is conventionally shown as consisting of 13 layers to refer to the 13 original states. Its symbolism is confirmed by "The generation which commences a revolution rarely completes it." – Thomas Jefferson. The adopting resolution provides that it is inscribed on its base with the date MDCCLXXVI (1776, the year of the United States Declaration of Independence, in Roman numerals). Where the top of the pyramid should be, the Eye of Providence watches over it. Two mottos appear: *Annuit Coeptis* signifies that Providence has "approved of (our) undertakings." *Annuit Coeptis* reflects the mottoes suggested by the third committee (*Deo Favente*) as well as by the first committee (Rebellion to Tyrants is Obedience to God). It further confirms our "**firm Reliance on the Protection of Divine Providence.**" – Declaration of Independence, 1776. The Latin motto: *E Pluribus Unum* describes an action- Many uniting into one. An accurate translation of the motto is "From Many, One" or "Out of Many, One" – a phrase that captures the symbolism on the shield. A "great" seal is the principal seal of a nation and have been used since the dawn of civilization. Plaintiff's Quintessential Rights of the 1<sup>st</sup> Amend. trusts these concepts.

### Remarks and Explanation

by Charles Thomson (June 20, 1782)

- The shield (escutcheon) is composed of thirteen stripes that represent the several states joined into one solid compact, supporting the chief (top section of the shield) which unites the whole and represents Congress. The stripes are kept closely united by the chief and the chief depends upon that union and the strength resulting from it.
- The motto *E Pluribus Unum* alludes to this union.
- The shield is born on the breast of an American Eagle without any other supporters to denote that the United States of America ought to rely on their own virtue.
- The olive branch and arrows denote the power of peace and war which is exclusively vested in Congress.
- The constellation of thirteen stars denotes a new state taking its place and rank among other sovereign powers.
- The pyramid signifies strength and duration.
- The Eye over it and the motto *Annuit Coeptis* allude to the many signal interpositions of providence in favor of the American cause.

The date 1776 underneath is that of the Declaration of Independence and the words *Novus Ordo Seclorum* under it signify the beginning of the new American Era, which commences from that date.
