## Protecting Taxpayer Civil Rights

The Internal Revenue Service does not tolerate discrimination by its employees against anyone because of age, color, disability, race, reprisal, national origin, English proficiency, **religion**, sex, sexual orientation or status as a parent.

This no-tolerance stance also applies to anyone who volunteers or works with taxpayers as part of any federally assisted program or any federally conducted program. This includes any interaction with IRS employees or activities sponsored by the IRS or one of these community assistance centers:

- Low Income Tax Clinics
- Volunteer Income Tax Assistance or
- Tax Counseling for the Elderly sites

If requested by a taxpayer, IRS employees and staff/volunteers at one of the assisted program sites will provide reasonable accommodation or language assistance.
